It is the story of six New Testament women as their stories become yours.

8 Old Testament women are presented and the lessons they have for women today are gold.

The author shows how all of us – Marys and Marthas alike – can draw closer to our Lord: Deepening our devotion, strengthening our service, and doing both with less stress and greater joy.

12 first person narratives from women who were contemporaries of Jesus and experienced him in a unique way.

This uses the biblical story of the meeting at the well between the Samaritan woman and Jesus to bring to light the path to a personal transformation we can all achieve if we hold on to hope and learn to listen for our Kairos moments.

Strong Was Her Faith: Women of the New Testament. J Ellsworth Kalas. Abingdon Press. 2007

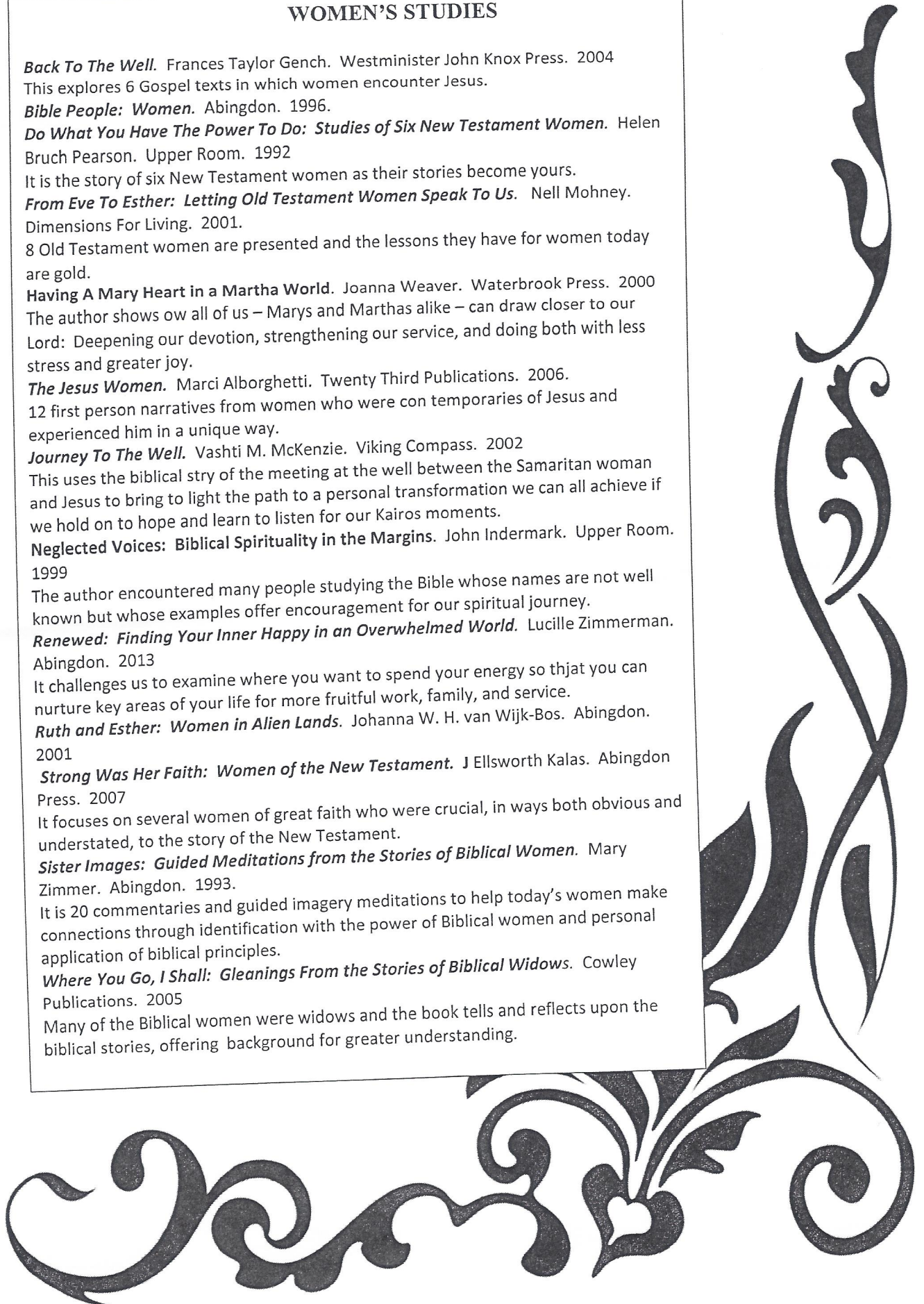
It focuses on several women of great faith who were crucial, in ways both obvious and understated, to the story of the New Testament.
