Sr Muriel Held, Suriname, and sr Lettice Joemath, South Africa, have been tasked to create a prayer chain within the UNITY. We have joined hearts, minds, hands and voices to find a practical way to include all provinces in prayer. Bring to the LORD all the issues concerning the consultation, to ask for His favor, guidance and His provision. Moravians are well known for our prayer vigil during the year. These are sacred moments for all intercessors to call on God to hear our petitions, intercessions, and prayers for His people and their causes. We can slightly deviate for our Prayer Chain. Mark 11:24 ESV: Therefore I tell you, whatever you ask in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it will be yours.

Try to dedicate on a regular basis time to pray for the Consultation as much as possible along the given scriptures. Every month directions will be given in the Whats App Group, which is created for the Western Hemisphere [Latin America and the Caribbean (incl. Guyana and Suriname), Alaska, Canada and the USA]. The focus will be on the work of the Unity Women's Desk and the theme of the Consultation

In the month of July we will focus on HANDS TO RECEIVE AND HANDS TO GIVE

1 Corinthians 1:30, MSG: Everything that we have – right thinking and right living, a clean slate and a fresh start – comes from God by way of Jesus Christ.

1 Chronicles 29:13-14 NIV: Now, our God, we give you thanks, and praise your glorious name. "But who am I, and who are my people, that we should be able to give as generously as this?"

Start your prayers with thanksgiving for hands which receive out of the loving hands of God, for loving hands who give to thankful receiving hands. Give praises to the Lord, for the work that has already been done; use the above scriptures to lead you in prayer. Pray for blessings and wisdom for future work and undertakings of the UWD. Choose one or more of the bible verses underneath to meditate. Call on God to hear your petitions, intercessions, and prayers to receive out of His hands and to give out of our hands to women and girls in need.

1. Meditate on **James 1:5 ESV**: If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask God, who gives generously to all without reproach, and it will be given him.
Pray for wisdom for the Planning of e.g. the program, Bible studies; logistics and finances;
2. **Psalms 104:28**: When You give it to them, they gather it up; when You open your hand, they are satisfied with good things.
Pray that the Lord opens His hands to give bountifully so that finances are sufficient for the Consultation and that enough volunteers will be available.
3. **Psalm 90:17**: Show us your mercy, O Lord our God. Confirm the work of our hands, the work of our hands, confirm that.
Pray for the work of the UWD that is being done among women, girls and families. Pray that the discussions on how to proceed after the Consultation, will be fruitful.

4. **Psalm 143:6:** I stretch out my hands to You, thirsty as dry earth.

Meditate on how we (UWD and we as individuals) can stretch out our hands to support those women and girls who are thirsty for (a better) education and for better developing chances in live

Close the month with

Psalm 20 :4: May He give us the desire of our hearts and make all our plans succeed.

Dear Lord, May we never forget that everything we have comes from You!

May we always remember that humility is the key to success!

May we always remember that we are blessed to be a blessing!

May we continually glorify and thank God with hearts and hands and voices for everything He has blessed us with!

For everything comes from Him and exists by His power and is intended for His glory. All glory to Him forever!
